### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to a home at 18XXX Hideaway Trail.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 20XXX Howland Avenue. A vehicle was spray painted.
- Motor Vehicle Theft was reported at 3XX Brutus Drive. The keys were inside the unlocked vehicle.
- Fraud Activity was reported after a victim was contacted about an employment opportunity and exchanged personal and financial information. The victim agreed to pay \$4,700.00 for job-related expenses before realizing it was a scam.
- A 24-year-old male driver was arrested for 4<sup>th</sup> Degree DUI, at Pilot Knob and CR-46, after testing a .10 BAC.
- Theft was reported by a victim who had moved into a new residence, hiring a moving company to assist. While unpacking items, several hundred dollars' worth of jewelry was placed on a counter. After the movers left the residence, the jewelry was gone.
- Theft of a vehicle license plate was reported at 20XXX Keokuk Avenue.
- Patrol responded to 17XXX Kenwood Trail and trespassed a 35-year-old male who had a history of theft at the business.
- Patrol arrested a 44-year-old female for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault.
- Officers responded to a Heroin overdose and administered Narcan. Medics transported the patient to the hospital for further care.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at Dodd Boulevard and Pilot Knob Road. A four-car pileup was caused after one at-fault driver rear-ended a vehicle. Fortunately, injuries reported were seemingly minor.
- A Traffic Stop, at CR-70 and Kenrick, resulted in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree DWI arrest of a 46-year-old male. He failed SFST's and tested a .15 BAC.
- Officers observed a driver stopped, northbound in the southbound lane of traffic, at CR-70 and Kenrick. A stop was initiated, and the 22-year-old male driver was identified. During the stop, he opted to throw the vehicle into drive and flee at a high rate of speed. A secondary stop was attempted but discontinued shortly after. The vehicle, with the same driver in it, was located a short time later by Burnsville PD. He refused DMT and had a prior DUI conviction. He was arrested on 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree DUI Refusal and Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle.
