### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Flagstaff Avenue. A mailbox was knocked over and multiple bottles were broken on the street.
- Theft was reported at Fleet Farm after a snowplow was stolen. The estimated loss is \$10k.
- Multiple officers responded to 20XXX Holiday Avenue on a reported structure fire. Upon arrival, heavy black smoke was billowing out of the residence. Luckily, all residents had successfully evacuated, and no injuries were reported. LFD expertly put out the fire. The home is likely a total loss from smoke and water damage.
- Patrol responded to a Suspicion call at 16XXX Kenrick Avenue and it was quickly determined the suspect vehicle was stolen out of Faribault. The 33-year-old male driver was jailed.
- Officers arrested a 20-year-old male for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault.
- Theft was reported at 21XXX Holyoke Avenue. A construction trailer was reportedly broken into and several items were taken. The total loss is estimated at \$6,000-\$7,000.
- Theft was reported at 21XXX Humboldt Court. A box truck and a trailer were stolen from the property.
- Fraud was reported after a check was altered, and deposited, by an unknown suspect, from a very small monetary value to over \$5k!
- Vehicle Theft was reported at 18XXX Hartlin Avenue. The vehicle had been rented out to a customer who has not yet returned it and, seemingly, didn't plan to. The stolen vehicle was later recovered in Brooklyn Park and two suspects were taken into custody.
- Burnsville and Lakeville PD's responded to a Crisis call at 162<sup>nd</sup> Street and I-35. Upon arrival, a female was located standing over the edge of the bridge - over southbound I-35 and outside of the safety fence. Freeway traffic was stopped for some time. After lengthy communication with officers and the crisis negotiation team, we're grateful to report she safely came down.

- A hit-and-run Traffic Accident was reported at 16XXX Goodview Way. A parked vehicle was struck and damaged overnight.
- A 27-year-old female driver turned northbound onto Dodd, from eastbound CR-70, on a flashing yellow. She pulled directly into the path of an oncoming driver. Injuries were reported to all parties involved. The at-fault driver was found to be impaired and in possession of alcohol, marijuana, and other narcotics. She was charged with 1<sup>st</sup> Degree DWI and Narcotics Possession.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue. A semi driver had all the engine oil to his truck drained after an unknown suspect pulled the drain plug.
- Officers responded to a Weapons call at 8XXX 176<sup>th</sup> Street. Neighbors reported hearing 2-3 gunshots in quick succession and the victim had a bullet come through the back of the house. Fortunately, no one was injured. Based on forensics, the suspect vehicle was parked in the back lot of Cherryview Elementary. Two shell casings were recovered there. Following the incident, the suspect vehicle quickly left the lot. The investigation is ongoing.
- Fraud was reported at 16XXX Gunflint Trail after a check, written for \$448, was stolen somewhere in the mailing process. It was then modified and issued to another party for \$6,500.00.
- Patrol responded to a Driving Complaint at 162<sup>nd</sup> Street West and Kenrick Avenue. The suspect vehicle was located and the 67-year-old male driver displayed signs of impairment. He was arrested for 4<sup>th</sup> Degree DWI after testing a .14 BAC.
- Another Traffic Stop, this time on Pilot Knob Road, found a 34-year-old male driver highly intoxicated. He tested a .20 BAC and was arrested without incident.
